Strengthening Rural Infrastructure, TPL Provides Support for Retaining Wall Construction in Toba

Sihilangon Hamlet, Pangombusan Village, Parmaksian District, Toba Regency, now has new infrastructure that addresses the needs of the local community. On Monday, November 25, 2024, PT Toba Pulp Lestari, Tbk (TPL) officially handed over the construction support for a Retaining Wall (TPT) to the residents of Pangombusan Village.
