

### **TPL Builds Additional Classroom Facilities for YBS School**

The groundbreaking ceremony for the construction of additional classrooms at Yayasan Bonapasogit Sejahtera (YBS) School, a school fostered by PT Toba Pulp Lestari (TPL), took place as part of efforts to provide better facilities for elementary school students.
